Yellow Pea

AAC Julius yields 4% higher than CDC Amarillo and AAC Lacombe with a significantly smaller seed size than the check. An exceptional variety with high seed cost integrity and seed coat breakage significantly lower than the checks. AAC Julius' high protein is similar to CDC Amarillo and even higher than AAC Lacombe.

- Small seed size
- Excellent rating for seed coat breakage
- High protein content
- Consistent high yields
- Semi-leafless
- Resistance to powdery mildew
